Summer Missions MAP 2009 / Gull Lake Ministries

Below is a list of tasks that our students and leaders did while at Gull Lake a few weeks ago. These things were occurred in about 3 1/2 work days (we would have worked more, but they were running out of things for us to do!). Thanks for working and praying for us on this formative week in our lives.

- Guttled a two story building, filling 3 dumpsters and cleaned up the interior and exterior
- Put in a split rail fence
- Moved 50 file boxes and shelves to the new building
- Deep cleaned Gethsemane cottage
- Power washed the outside and deck of Gethsemane
- Deep cleaned the old Youth Chapel
- Edged and put rocks along the parking area near the beach

- Spread 4 loads of dirt on an area
- Took out two large over grown bushes outside the game room
- Spread mulch around game room
- Washed GLM work vehicles
- Burned a very large brush pile
- Trimmed the bushes all along the beach area and game room

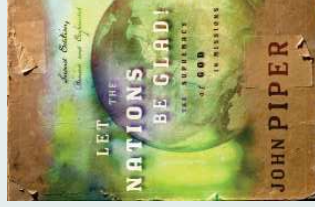
